- 1993 – Herb Douglas: First Pittsburgher to win Olympic Medal, Long Jump, London 1948 *With Plate Numbers - \$3.00 each
- 1994 – Chuck Cooper: First Black Drafted by NBA - From Duquesne University
- 1995 – Babe Ruth: Hit His Last Three Home-runs in one game at Forbes Field, 1935
- 1996 – John Woodruff: First Pitt Olympic Gold Medal Winner - 800 Meters, Berlin, 1936
- 1997 – Glenn "Pop" Warner: Pitt Coach - Undefeated Football Season, 1917
- 1998 – Kennywood Park: 100th Anniversary (Franked with four different Carousel Horses).
- 1999 – First Televised Collegiate Touchdown - Scored by Bobby Brooks of Waynesburg College, VS Fordham, 1939
- 2000 – Bill Mazerowski: Hit Winning Home Run in 1960 World Series. **SOLD OUT**
- 2001 – End of Three Rivers Stadium
- 2002 – Cal Hubbard: Only Person in both Major League Baseball and NFL Halls-Of-Fame - from Geneva College
- 2003 – Willie Thrower: First Black Quarterback in NFL - 1953, from New Kensington, PA
- 2004 – Dick Groat: "The Ultimate Impact Player" from Duke Basketball and Pittsburgh Pirates Shortstop Great
- 2005 – Arnold Palmer: 50th Anniversary of Victory in Canadian Open - His First Professional Tour
- 2006 – Myron Cope: Sports writer who became "The Voice" of the Pittsburgh Steelers for 35 years - from 1970 - 2005
- 2007 – Elroy Face: Pittsburgh Pirates Forkball Pitcher, 1952 - 1968. His 18 - 1 record in 1959 included 17 victories in a row.
- 2008 – Steve Blass: Last Pirate Pitcher to win two complete games in a World Series - 1971
- 2009 – Harvey Haddix: First Major League Pitcher to take a Perfect Game Past Nine Innings, Pittsburgh Pirates, 1959
- 2010 – Vernon Law: Pittsburgh Pirates Pitcher for 16 Seasons – Won Games One and Four in 1960 World Series VS Yankees
- 2011 – Chuck Noll: Still the ONLY NFL Coach to win FOUR Super Bowls, 1974, 1976, 1978, and 1979
- 2012 – Jack Butler: One of the Newest Pittsburgh Steelers to be inducted into the NFL Hall-of-Fame – (4 Aug 2012) One of their best players during the 1950s
- 2013 – Bob Friend: Pittsburgh Pirates Great Sinking Fastball Pitcher – first pitcher to lead NL in ERA while pitching for a last place team.
- 2014 – Andy Russell: Former Pittsburgh Steeler Linebacker, original "Steel Curtain" member, Team captain ten times
- 2015 – Kent Tekulve: Former Pittsburgh Pirate Pitcher known as "The Rubber Band Man"
- 2016 – Rocky Bleier: Pittsburgh Steelers running back; four time AFC and Super Bowl Champion and a member of the Pittsburgh Pro Hall of Fame
- 2017 – Gene Baker: First African-American Manager in organized baseball -- 1963.;
- 2018 – The Pittsburgh Pipers take the win 122-113 in the first ABA Championship ever played. On May 4th, 1960 the stars came out in Pittsburgh
- 2019 – George Blanda: Quarterback and Kicker for the AFL and NFL Inducted into the Hall of Fame in 1981
- 2020 – Bruno Sammartino: Dubbed "The Italian Strongman" and "The Strongest Man in the World" early in his career, Sammartino later earned the title "The Living Legend". Known for his powerful "bearhug" finishing move, he is widely regarded as one of the greatest professional wrestlers of all time
