

Precanceled 1969 Christmas Stamp first-day covers offer a challenge

Among the scarcest modern US first-day covers are for the precanceled 1969 6 cent Christmas stamps. The art was the painting Winter Sunday in Norway, Maine, depicting a horse-drawn sleigh in a snowy New England town. The Post Office Department decided to experiment with precanceled stamps to see if they would save processing time and therefor money. The precancels were tried in 4 cities – Atlanta, Baltimore, Memphis and New Haven. The hope was that people would bundle their Christmas cards with these precancels and save time by now having to be machine canceled. It was a moderate success – many people in these cities did use the precancels and bundled their cards, but others did not, and the majority of these stamps ended up with regular machine cancels. The local printing of the precancel on the stamps was also not consistent, resulting in errors and many varieties. The first day of issue was November 3, 1969, and all four cities offered FDCs but not many exist. The last auction reference the author had was from 2013, when a set of four was estimated at \$400 -\$600.
