 - Blueberries (January 9th) 4 cent stamps, very juicy!
 - US Flags (Jan. 9th) Forever stamp with flags a classic.
 - Priority Mail Stamps (Jan. 9th) \$8.95 & \$26.95 designs to be a surprise!

- Love (Jan 14th) 2 Forever Stamps in the continuing Love series.
- Chinese New Year Year of the Tiger (Jan 20th) by the same artist as the last 3 years.
- Edmonia Lewis (Jan 26th) Continuing the Black Heritage Series, this shows the famous 19th Century sculptor.

I had a reply from Phil Bronner, who lives in Springfield, Oregon, who said he has lived in 14 ZIP Codes where he has received mail 01104, 01108, 01085, 08640, 46216, 66442, 66502, 01001, 66048, 97038, 97013, 97045, 97424, 97478. He also said he enjoys the newsletter and has all but one of our Souvenir sheets.
- Many of the countries of the world came out with COVID-19 stamps during 2020 and 2021, including such clever ones as Austria's Toilet Paper (2020) and Face Mask (2021) stamps.





In 2020 21 different countries and the UN released more than 60 stamps acknowledging the pandemic and honoring the health care and essential workers who continued to work during the lock downs. **None of these stamps were from the United Stamps.** It is not known if the USPS plans on issuing any stamps about the pandemic.
